

ST PETERSBURG TOUR

FROM MOSCOW

6:45 Meet your driver in the lobby of your hotel in Moscow. Car transfer to Train Station. Driver will assist in finding your train.

7:30 Depart to St Petersburg by 4-hr speed train Sapsan

11:40 Arrive to St Petersburg. Meet your local guide and driver by the train.

Nevsky prospect – main street of Saint Petersburg stretching 4 km.

Peter & Paul Fortress (includes entrance fees) – defensive fortress built by order of Peter the Great, burial place of Romanovs, former political prison.

Bronze Horseman – the sculpture to the founder of the city Peter the Great, commissioned by Catherine the Great years after his death. Sometimes interpreted as her attempt to formalize the link between them.

St. Isaac Cathedral – Built by French designer Auguste Montferrand 158 years ago. 112 columns and more than 100kg of gold leaf was used to cover the 21m-high dome alone. Entrance optional.

Savior on the Blood Church – took 24 years to build on the spot of assassination of Czar Alexander II in 1881. Entrance optional.

Hermitage Museum (includes entrance fees) – one of the largest and most significant art museums in the world, located in winter palace.

Guide will recommend a restaurant for lunch. Expenses not included.

19:00 Depart back to Moscow by 4-hr speed train Sapsan

23:00 Arrive to Moscow. Meet your driver by the train. Transfer to Moscow Hotel.

Program includes: 2 transfers in Moscow, 2-way Train tickets, Local guide and driver, entrance fees to Peter and Paul Fortress and Hermitage.

Guide and driver tips are not included in price. Tipping in Russia 10-15% is optional but appreciated.
